

Procedure for online Merit Badges

1. Scout must contact both Mr. Leonard and Mrs. Kearney (rayleonard2@gmail.com and SherryKny@aol.com) for approval prior to starting the MB. (note: parents should not start bluecards in Scoutbook.) Please do this even if you are continuing work on a partial.
2. If you are starting a MB other than one sponsored by T32 or the Redwood Empire Council (REC) please provide the MB Counselor's name and contact info to Mrs. Kearney.
3. Mrs. Kearney will add the MB to the Scout's Advancement page in Scoutbook, and "invite" the Merit Badge Counselor to Scoutbook.
4. T32 MB Counselors will use Scoutbook to record completed requirements. For REC sponsored merit badges, please either follow the instructions given when you register or contact the MB Counselor directly**. Some MB Counselors may use an online bluecard pdf.
5. The Scout must notify Mrs. Kearney when the MB has been completed.

** Be sure to ALWAYS add another adult to all communications for two deep youth protection; you can use 2deep@troop32.org.
